## State Fiscal Analysis

• *New Capital Appropriations.* The bill appropriates \$144.5 million in capital funds to the Public Works Commission for the FY 2009 – FY 2010 biennium. These new capital appropriations are summarized in Table 1.

• *Capital Reappropriations.* The bill reappropriates approximately \$5.85 billion in capital funds for the FY 2009 – FY 2010 biennium. This amount represents an estimate of available moneys on July 1, 2008. Generally, the actual reappropriation will be equal to the actual moneys available on July 1, 2008. These capital reappropriations are summarized in the following two tables starting on the following page. Table 2 presents the estimated amounts by fund. Table 3 presents the estimated amounts by fund and agency.
