State and Local Fiscal Analysis

Adult and Juvenile Correctional Facilities Bond Retirement Fund

H.B. 153 of the 129th General Assembly created the Adult and Juvenile Correctional Facilities Bond Retirement Fund to receive the proceeds from the sale of adult or juvenile correctional facilities. The bill eliminates a requirement that cash in the fund first be used to redeem or annul any outstanding bond debt issued for the facilities sold. The bill also permits the transfer of cash, under certain conditions, from the fund to the Adult Correctional Building Fund and the Juvenile Correctional Building Fund in addition to the General Revenue Fund, as required under current law.

Capital reappropriations

The bill reappropriates approximately \$1.23 billion in capital funds for the FY 2013-FY 2014 biennium. This amount represents an estimate of available moneys on July 1, 2012. Generally, the actual reappropriations will be equal to the actual moneys available on July 1, 2012. These capital reappropriations are summarized in the two tables starting on the following page. Table 1 presents the estimated amounts by fund. Table 2 presents the estimated amounts by fund and agency.
