DASCD28 Prescription Drug Transparency and Affordability Advisory Council

R.C. 125.95

Specifies that the Director of Administrative Services is the chairperson of the existing Prescription Drug Transparency and Affordability Advisory Council. Eliminates the requirement that the Council meet quarterly and instead specifies that it meets at the call of the chairperson.

Replaces the Executive provision with one that abolishes the Prescription Drug Transparency and Affordability Advisory Council on the amendment's effective date.

Permits the Joint Medicaid Oversight Committee (JMOC) to examine any of the topics described in the report on various aspects of the state's prescription drug purchasing programs previously prepared by the Council if requested by any JMOC member.

Fiscal effect: Slight decrease in administrative costs for DAS.

No provision.	No provision.	<p>Requires the Medicaid Director to also report to the executive director and members of JMO if there is a rate increase pending before the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for any of those fees.</p> <p>Fiscal effect: Potential administrative costs.</p>
