Legal Basis: R.C. 103.41; Section 313.10 of H.B. 110 of the 134th G.A. (originally created in Section 9 of S.B. 206 of the 130th G.A.)

Purpose: This line item supports operating expenses related to the Joint Medicaid Oversight Committee (JMOC). JMOC is responsible for providing ongoing legislative oversight of the state's Medicaid Program. This includes: contracting with an actuary before the beginning of each fiscal biennium to determine the projected medical inflation rate; reviewing how Medicaid relates to the public and private provision of health care coverage; recommending improvements in Medicaid statutes and rules; and developing a plan of action for the future of Medicaid.

H.B. 110 of 134th G.A. provides certain specific activities for JMOC including that, before making any payment rate increases greater than 10% under the Medicaid program, the Medicaid director is required to notify JMOC of the increase. The Director is further required to be available to testify before JMOC regarding the increase. JMOC is also permitted to examine any topics described in the report on various aspects of the state's prescription drug purchasing programs previously prepared by the Prescription Drug Transparency and Affordability Advisory Council (which is abolished by H.B. 110 of the 134th G.A), if such an examination is requested by any JMOC member.
