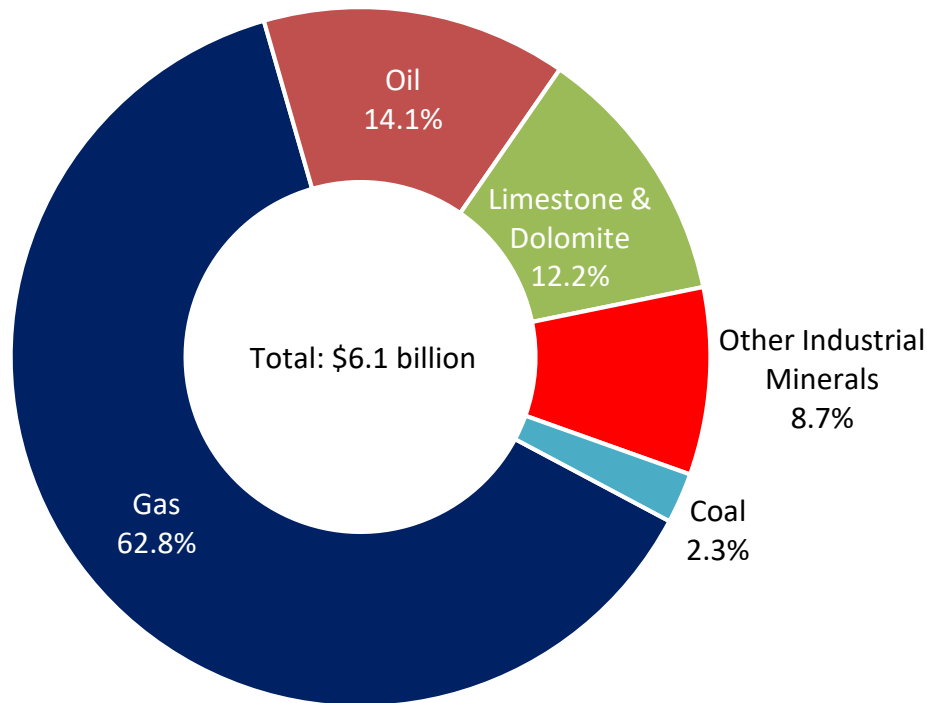


Natural gas is Ohio's dominant mineral resource

Value of Minerals Produced in Ohio, 2020

- The value of mineral resources extracted in Ohio totaled approximately \$6.1 billion in 2020.
 - Natural Gas – \$3.8 billion
 - Oil – \$855.5 million
 - Limestone and dolomite – \$737.2 million
 - Other industrial minerals (sand & gravel, salt, sandstone, shale, clay, and peat) – \$525.2 million
 - Coal – \$141.2 million
- Natural gas production topped 2.36 billion Mcf* in 2020. The top producing counties were:
 - Belmont – 833.7 million Mcf
 - Jefferson – 484.6 million Mcf
 - Monroe – 481.5 million Mcf
 - Harrison – 263.1 million Mcf
 - Carroll – 84.3 million Mcf

*Mcf = 1,000 cubic feet
