

## State general operating revenue grew 69.2% in the past two decades

- In nominal terms, state general operating revenue increased 69.2% since FY 2004, from \$25.90 billion to \$43.83 billion in FY 2024.
- State tax receipts are the largest component at \$28.92 billion (66.0%) in FY 2024, having risen 52.7% since FY 2004.
- Federal grants are the next largest component at \$12.65 billion (28.9%) in FY 2024, having risen 129.2% since FY 2004.
- State general operating revenue fell by about \$1.16 billion (2.6%) from FY 2023 to FY 2024.
