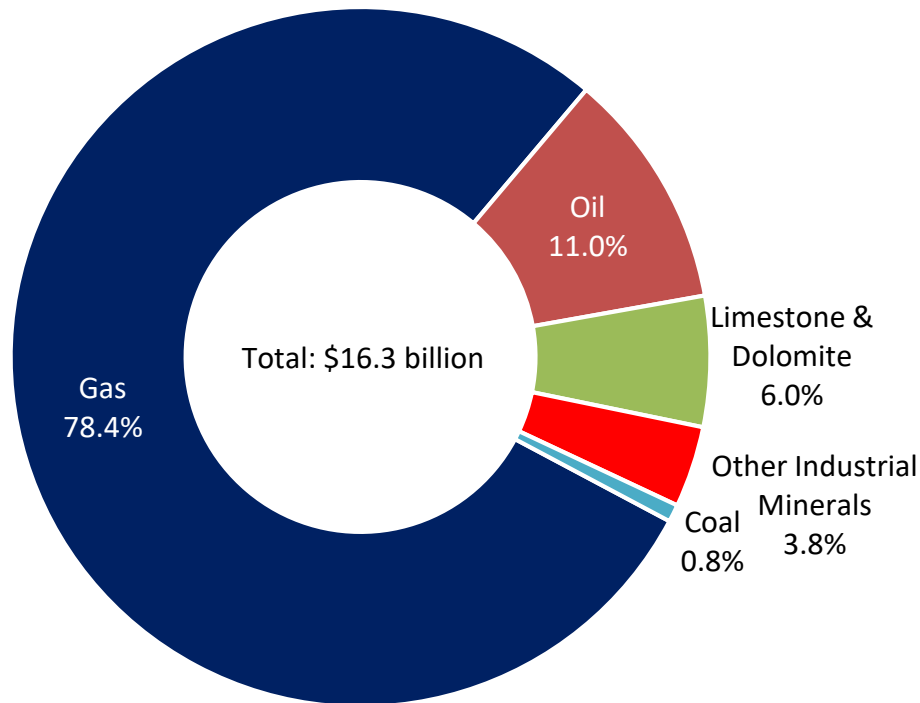


# Natural gas is Ohio's dominant mineral resource

Value of Minerals Produced in Ohio, 2022

- The value of mineral resources extracted in Ohio totaled approximately \$16.3 billion in 2022.
  - Natural Gas – \$12.8 billion
  - Oil – \$1.8 billion
  - Limestone and dolomite – \$984.2 million
  - Other industrial minerals (sand & gravel, salt, sandstone, shale, clay, and peat) – \$612.4 million
  - Coal – \$130.6 million
- Natural gas production neared 2.22 billion Mcf\* in 2022. The top producing counties were:
  - Belmont – 583.6 million Mcf
  - Jefferson – 550.0 million Mcf
  - Monroe – 423.8 million Mcf
  - Harrison – 314.6 million Mcf
  - Carroll – 94.2 million Mcf

\*Mcf = 1,000 cubic feet
