- GRF tax revenues exceeded estimates each month in FY 2022. In June, the last month of the fiscal year, GRF tax revenues were above estimate by \$179.7 million (7.1%), resulting in a positive fiscal year variance of \$2.74 billion (10.8%).
- ♦ The sales and use tax had the largest positive variance in June at \$124.6 million (12.0%), followed by the personal income tax at \$50.1 million (5.1%). These positive monthly variances increased the positive annual variances in these taxes to \$714.8 million (5.8%) and \$1.85 billion (20.8%), respectively.
- Transfers in to the GRF were \$319.7 million under estimate in June as OBM opted to not make expected transfers including \$212.8 million in excess commercial activity tax revenue deposited in non-GRF funds and \$100.0 million in transfers from rotary funds.
- Federal grants deposited into the GRF were above estimate by \$285.8 million (37.1%) in June, reflecting GRF Medicaid spending, which was above estimate by \$310.3 million (28.3%) in June. These June variances increased the annual positive variances to \$1.28 billion (12.1%) for federal grants and \$1.12 billion (7.0%) for GRF Medicaid spending. Non-GRF Medicaid spending, on the other hand, was under estimate for the year by \$1.91 billion (9.6%) and all funds Medicaid was under the annual estimate by \$789.1 million (2.2%).
- GRF program expenditures were above estimate by \$580.4 million (1.6%) for the fiscal year, reflecting the positive GRF Medicaid variance being partially offset by negative variances in other categories. Transfers out were above estimate by \$98.7 million (3.3%) for the year, primarily because of transfers authorized in bills enacted after H.B. 110.
