# LBO BUDGET FOOTNOTES INFOGRAPHIC

- GRF tax revenues were over estimate in June, the last month of FY 2023, by \$153.5 million (5.9%), bringing the positive variance in GRF tax revenue to \$994.2 million (3.6%) for the fiscal year.
- The personal income tax ended the year \$645.1 million (6.4%) over estimate, buoyed by a positive variance of \$59.8 million (6.6%) in June.
- The sales and use tax, the largest GRF tax revenue source, had a positive June variance at \$21.3 million (1.8%), which pushed its FY 2023 positive variance to \$149.2 million (1.1%).
- ♦ The commercial activity tax met the estimate in June and ended the year \$82.9 million (4.0%) over estimate.
- FY 2023 GRF Medicaid spending was under estimate by \$1.42 billion (7.1%). This amount was partially offset by a positive FY 2023 variance in non-GRF Medicaid spending, which ended the year \$718.1 million (4.2%) over estimate. This resulted in all funds Medicaid expenditures being below estimate by \$702.3 million (1.9%) for the fiscal year.
- ♦ Most other GRF program categories were also under estimate for FY 2023, so that GRF program expenditures totaling \$37.78 billion were below estimate by \$1.81 billion (4.6%) for the fiscal year.
- ♦ Total GRF uses were under the FY 2023 estimate by \$1.31 billion (3.2%), as transfers out ended the year \$499.8 million (27.9%) over estimate, mainly due to a transfer of \$727.0 million into the Budget Stabilization Fund authorized in H.B. 45 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly that was partially offset by a negative FY 2023 variance in transfers out for capital projects.
