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• GRF tax revenues were under estimate in April by \$178.1 million (6.0%). This was the first month in FY 2023 that tax revenues did not meet estimate. For the year-to-date (YTD) GRF tax revenue, totaling \$23.41 billion, was \$626.6 million (2.7%) over estimate.

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- The personal income tax had the largest negative April variance at \$122.3 million (8.2%), followed by the sales and use tax at \$65.3 million (5.2%). For the YTD, these taxes were over estimate by \$343.4 million (4.0%) and \$144.3 million (1.3%), respectively.
- GRF Medicaid expenditures had a negative variance in April of \$320.8 million (31.4%), increasing the negative YTD variance to \$1.02 billion (6.2%). Non-GRF Medicaid spending on the other hand, was above estimate for the month and the YTD. This resulted in all funds Medicaid expenditures being below estimate by \$19.0 million (0.7%) for the month and by \$562.8 million (1.8%) for the YTD.
- Most other GRF program categories were also under estimate for the YTD, so that program expenditures were below the YTD estimate by \$1.61 billion (4.8%) at the end of April.
- Total GRF uses, however, were under the YTD estimate by just \$27.5 million (0.1%) due to transfers out, which were over estimate mainly due to a transfer of \$727.0 million into the Budget Stabilization Fund authorized in H.B. 45 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly and also large timing-related positive variances in transfers out for capital projects.
