



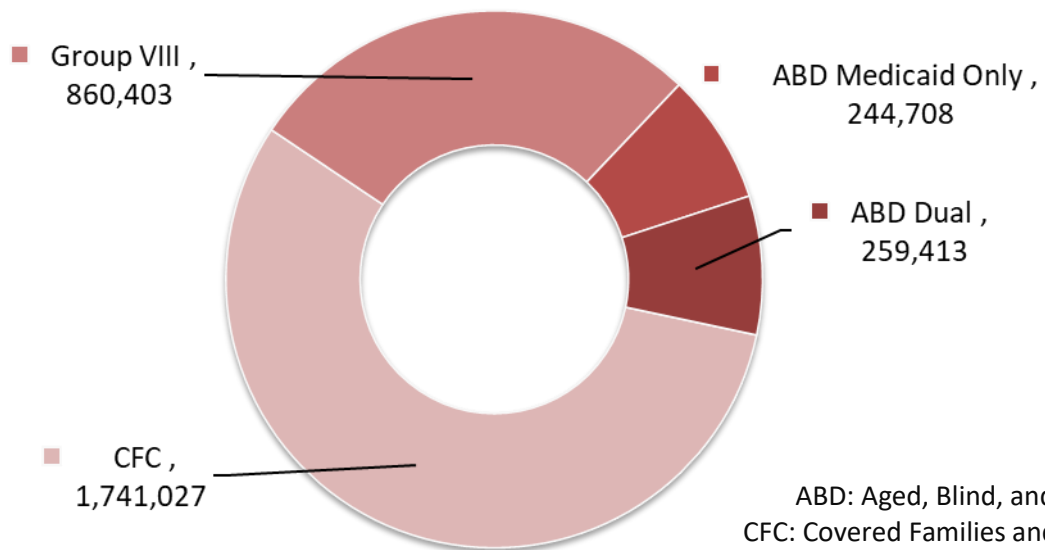
Medicaid Caseload at a Glance

September 2024

Over one quarter of all Ohioans were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2024

- ◆ 3.24 million (27.5%) of Ohio’s 11.79 million residents were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2024.
- ◆ 3.11 million (95.8%) of Medicaid enrollees received full benefits; 136,500 (4.2%) received limited or Medicare premium or copayment assistance benefits.
- ◆ Of the 3.11 million enrollees who received full benefits, 2.85 million (91.7%) were served by managed care (MC) plans, and 258,000 (8.3%) received fee-for-service (FFS) care.

ABD: Aged, Blind, and Disabled

 Dual: Eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare
 Group VIII: Expansion group established by the Affordable Care Act

Service Methods for CFC

- ◆ 98.0% of enrollees received managed care
- ◆ 2.0% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for Group VIII

- ◆ 92.2% of enrollees received managed care
- ◆ 7.8% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for ABD Medicaid Only and ABD Dual

- ◆ 81.5% of Medicaid Only enrollees received managed care, and 18.5% of Medicaid Only enrollees received FFS care
- ◆ 57.3% of Dual enrollees received managed care, and 42.7% of Dual enrollees received FFS care
