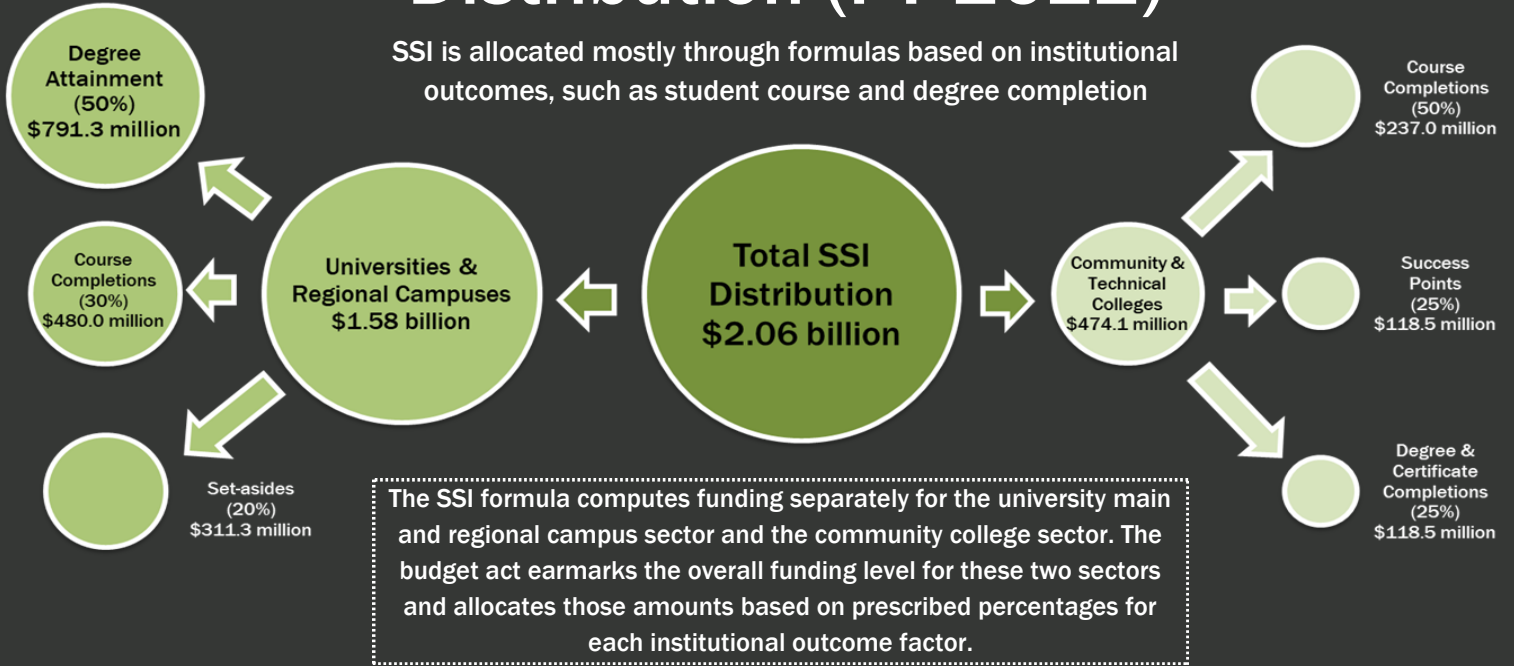


# State Share of Instruction

- ★ Serves as Ohio's primary financial support to public higher education
- ★ Provides unrestricted operating subsidies to Ohio's 61 public colleges and universities, funding a portion of the operating costs of serving approximately 299,000 full-time equivalent (FTE) students

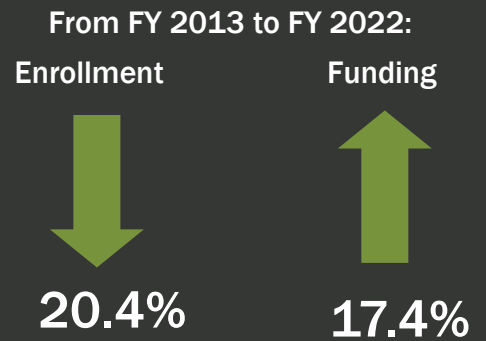
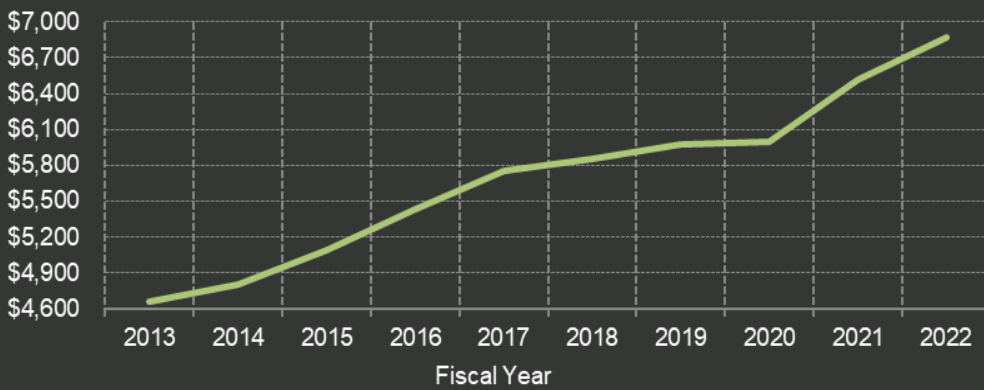
## Distribution (FY 2022)

SSI is allocated mostly through formulas based on institutional outcomes, such as student course and degree completion



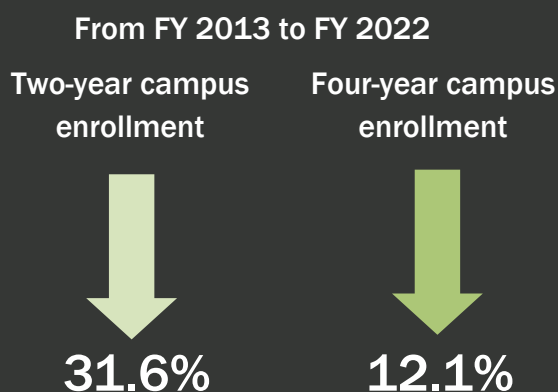
★ On a per-student basis, SSI reached a decade high of **\$6,872** in FY 2022

SSI Per FTE Student, FY 2013-FY 2022



SSI per student increased 47.6% since FY 2013 due to declining enrollment and increased appropriations

Total subsidy-eligible FTEs at public colleges and universities have decreased every year since FY 2013, led by two-year campuses
