
Medicaid Caseload at a Glance

August 2022

More than one in four Ohioans were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2022

- 3.33 million (28.3%) of Ohio's 11.78 million residents were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2022.
- 3.19 million (95.8%) of Medicaid enrollees received full benefits; 141,000 (4.2%) received limited or Medicare premium or copayment assistance benefits.
- Of the 3.19 million enrollees who received full benefits,
 2.93 million (92.0%) were served by managed care (MC) plans,
 and 254,000 (8.0%) were served by fee-for-service (FFS) care.

Dual: Eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare Group VIII: Expansion group established by the Affordable Care Act

Service Methods for CFC

- 98.1% of enrollees received managed care
- ♦ 1.9% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for Group VIII

- 92.6% of enrollees received managed care
- ♦ 7.4% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for ABD Medicaid Only and ABD Dual

- 81.7% of Medicaid Only enrollees received managed care, and 18.3% of Medicaid Only enrollees received FFS care
- ♦ 56.5% of Dual enrollees received managed care, and 43.5% of Dual enrollees received FFS care
