

Ohio Healthier Buckeye Advisory Council

2017 Annual Report as required by ORC 5101.91

The Ohio Healthier Buckeye Advisory Council was formed by the 130th General Assembly. The Ohio Healthier Buckeye Advisory Council was created to serve as a resource to local healthier buckeye councils.

H.B. 49 of the 132nd General Assembly, the biennial budget, extended the Healthier Buckeye Grant Pilot Program to allow those who were awarded grants more time to complete their work. Grants were extended until December 31, 2017. After grant close-out activities, this report will be amended.
